- **The National Tramway Museum:** featuring vintage tram rides, a recreated period street, and the impressive National Tram Collection of over 90 trams.
- **Peak Rail:** offering scenic steam and diesel train journeys through the Derbyshire countryside, alongside period stations and heritage displays.
- **Midland Railway – Butterley:** a family-friendly day out with steam train rides, museum exhibits, and historic locomotives.

Together, these attractions represent some of the finest examples of preserved transport heritage in the UK. The pass not only offers excellent value but encourages visitors to discover more of what Derbyshire has to offer during their stay.
